- A high level of understanding of Safeguarding and Protecting of Children and Young People particularly in relation to Disabled children and young people.
- The ability and proven track record to work independently and as part of a team
- Excellent communication skills including the ability to converse with a range stakeholders and children and young people with varying communication needs
- The ability to build and maintain effective relationships with Disabled children and young people and their families
- Confident in managing individualised care plans, such as behaviour support plans, epilepsy care plans, peg care plans, manual handling guidelines etc and creating working relationships with parents and other professionals to ensure that we always have the most up to date information for the children and young people in our care
